▲ READ AND FOLLOW ALL SAFETY WARNINGS AND INSTRUCTIONS IN THE OWNER'S MANUAL BEFORE OPERATING THE LIGHTS IN YOUR FISHERMAN'S COMBO.

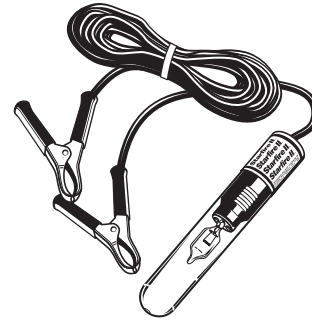
▲ WARNING

- Do not touch lens when light is on or if it was recently on. The lens will be hot and could cause serious burns.
- Keep battery clips or cigarette lighter plug dry and out of water at all times.
- Do not place lights in water when lamp is hot. Lights must be disconnected from power source and cool before placing in water. Sudden extreme changes in temperature could cause bulb or lens to shatter.
- Always disconnect lights from power source and allow to cool for at least one minute before removing light from water. Sudden extreme changes in temperature could cause bulb or lens to shatter causing bodily injury.
- Starfire II light tube must be fully submerged in water before attaching battery clips to terminals.
- Starfire II is designed to be used underwater only.
- Do not operate Starfire II if there is water in the globe or if the light bubbles when placed in water. Fog inside the globe without the presence of water is normal.
- Do not allow children to handle or operate these lights.
- Do not use this product for other than its intended use.
- Do not operate in close proximity of combustible or flammable materials.
- Do not attempt to operate light if cord, plug, bulb or any part of the lights are damaged or corroded.
- Prior to connecting the lights to a battery of an inboard boat, the blower must be activated to remove combustible fumes.
- Do not attempt to make your own repairs or adjustments.

Step 1: With boat motor turned off, lower light below water surface to desired depth, at least 2-feet below water surface.

▲ WARNING: If boat is an inboard, the blower must be activated to remove combustible fumes prior to connecting light.

Step 2: Connect battery clips to battery terminals.

Step 3: Drop baited hook six to ten feet below light and bring hook up one foot at a time until you get a strike.

Step 4: To deactivate, remove clips from battery terminals. Do not remove from water until light has cooled for at least one minute.

▲ WARNING: Do not attempt to make your own repairs or adjustments.

1-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

For 1-year from date of purchase, The Brinkmann Corporation warrants the Starfire II against defects due to workmanship or materials to the original purchaser. The Brinkmann Corporation's obligations under this warranty are limited to the following guidelines:

- This warranty does not extend to the bulb or glass tube.
- This warranty does not cover lights that have been altered/modified or damaged due to: normal wear, abuse, improper maintenance and/or improper use.
- This warranty does not cover surface scratches or weathering as this is considered normal wear.
- Warranty service is limited to repair or replacement of lights which prove defective under normal use and which upon examination shall indicate to Brinkmann's satisfaction, they are defective. If Brinkmann confirms the defect and approves the claim, Brinkmann will elect to repair or replace the light as covered by the terms of this warranty.
- This warranty extends to the original purchaser only and is not transferable or assignable to subsequent purchasers.

The Brinkmann Corporation requires reasonable proof of purchase. Therefore, we strongly recommend that you retain your sales receipt or invoice. To obtain repair or replacement of your Starfire II under the terms of this warranty, please call Customer Service Department at 1-800-527-0717 for a Return Authorization Number and further instructions. A receipt will be required. Spotlights returned to Brinkmann must include your name, address and telephone number. Please make sure the light is properly packed, postage prepaid, and insured. **A Return Authorization Number must be clearly marked on the outside of the box.** The Brinkmann Corporation will not be responsible for any spotlights forwarded to us without a Return Authorization Number.
